461 Prospect Circle - This is the home of David Galvery, who has lived there since 1980. It has undergone many additions and changes through the years. The garden includes a pair of mythical griffons, flanking a pond fed by a waterfall whose rushing water deters outside traffic noise. This inviting low maintenance retreat is lush and green year round and includes a tropical pavilion which sets the stage for pure relaxation and entertaining.

410 Prospect Circle - Katherine and Robert Watkins are the owners of this 1928 Tudor Revival home. Since the early 1980s when they bought the house, they have gradually changed the landscaping to the English Cottage Garden style. Cottage gardens are characterized as seemingly haphazard and densely planted. This carefully laid out garden repeats texture and color, thus achieving a sense of balance. It has over 100 roses - most of which are David Austin English roses. They grow among annuals and
